AERA Endurance Logbook	
Fulfil the FEI Endurance Novice Qualifications. Must have completed 2x40km rides + 2x80km AERA Rides (min. 12 months must be completed within 24 month period) to compete in a CEI 1* event <a href="https://www.equestrian.org.au/news/fei-endurance-novice-qualifications">https://www.equestrian.org.au/news/fei-endurance-novice-qualifications</a> .	
<i>Note – at FEI/CEI events in Australia, AERA Novice rules will apply to both horse &amp; rider whilst participating at events <a href="http://www.aera.asn.au/index.php/administration/rules-and-policies">www.aera.asn.au/index.php/administration/rules-and-policies</a></i>	
Horse must be a min. 6 years of age to enter a CEI1* event.	
Horse registered with EA State Branch – minimum Base Horse Registration. Horse will be required to be micro-chipped.	
Horse to be registered with FEI. Registrations via Equestrian Australia <a href="http://www.rideahorse.com.au/fei-forms">www.rideahorse.com.au/fei-forms</a> or <a href="https://www.equestrian.org.au/endorance-Horse-FEI-Registration">https://www.equestrian.org.au/endorance-Horse-FEI-Registration</a> for both horse and rider registration	
Passport Requirements through Equestrian Australia – <a href="http://www.rideahorse.com.au/fei-forms">www.rideahorse.com.au/fei-forms</a>	
Apply for an EA National Passport for Domestic CEI1* and 2* events. Apply for an FEI Passport for CEI3* and above or for horse to participate overseas. <i>You may Apply for an FEI Recognition Card if horse already has an EA National Passport.</i>	
<i>Note: Apply a min. of 3 weeks before passports are required, to allow for processing and delays with postage. Do not leave the passport application to the last minute. Contact Equestrian Australia if issues arise.</i>	
Download FEI HorseApp to be completed prior to and attending all events. <a href="https://inside.fei.org/hub/it-services/mobile-apps/%20fei_horseapp">https://inside.fei.org/hub/it-services/mobile-apps/%20fei_horseapp</a>
