## About the Ride Base Facilities:

Excellent toilet and shower facilities. Powered sites available. Plenty of room for BYO fencing (needs to comply with QERA rules). It is a Tepon requirement that you put all manure and feed left-overs into designated areas before leaving the grounds (not at the base of trees) and either put your rubbish in the bins if provided or take it home with you. There are pubs, cafes and a mini-mart in Herberton + takeaways available at the Wondecla Roadhouse, just up the road. Tepon camping fee: \$10 per camp per night, payable via Aeraonline when nominating.
