How to Nominate and Pay:	All nominations and payments for this ride will be taken via Aeraonline at Aeraonline Cordillera Trail Event Page 2026 Early Bird nominations will close at Midnight on Friday the 18th of September 2026, after which time, nominations will incur a \$20 late fee (a nomination made prior to cut off may be added to or changed without incurring a late fee). Cancellations of nominations must be made in writing and there will be no refund applicable after Friday the 18th of September 2026 unless for medical grounds or family emergency to the committee's discretion. * the committee reserves the right to cancel rides if insufficient numbers of nominations are received. ** the times listed below are approximate and subject to change.

Presentation Time:	Following completion of each day Approx. 6:00pm daily
About the Track:	The tracks will be undulating, including hill work, forestry tracks, some road work and rockiness underfoot. There will be ample natural watering spots + supplied water if necessary.
Vetting and Ride Governance:	Vetting: AERA Standard. Head vet: Matthew Walker Chief Steward: Michael Sheehan RO: FNERA Committee
About the Ride Base Facilities:	Excellent toilet and shower facilities. Powered sites available. Some permanent horse yards available on a first-in basis for \$20 per yard, maximum of 2 yards per camp. Plenty of room for BYO fencing (needs to comply with QERA rules). It is a Tepon requirement that you put all manure and feed left-overs into designated areas before leaving the grounds (not at the base of trees) and either put your rubbish in the bins if provided or take it home with you. There are pubs, cafes and a mini-mart in Herberton + takeaways available at the Wondecla Roadhouse, just up the road. Tepon camping fee: \$10 per camp per night, payable via Aeraonline when nominating.
Ride Nomination Fees:	20km \$45 (day member \$65) \$40 first time riders / 40km \$70 (day member \$90) / 60km (Elevated) \$80 (day member \$100) / 80km \$130 (Gold Card \$110) 120km mini marathon \$200 (QERA member and previously completed 2 x 40km rides. Horse must have a logbook) / 60km micro marathon \$110 (day members \$150) / Kids Ride \$20. Non FNERA member fee \$25 per event (Not applicable to first time riders)
Biosecurity measures:	Open Ride – Refer Biosecurity Document. Please hand in your fully completed 3 day Horse Health Declaration/s & show your vaccination certificate/s on arrival. MUST have PIC recorded on all your paperwork
Dogs Allowed:	Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
Fires Allowed:	Fires in drums on the grounds are currently permitted.
Early Arrivals:	Approval only via prior notification.
